

INTENT OF MOTIONS BELOW: The intent of the two (2) motions below is to increase the effectiveness of the LRC Representative position while reducing the cost to the Local.

INSTRUCTIONS: Please read the below proposed Constitutional changes (*italic* = new language, ~~strike~~ = deleted language) and vote yes or no by marking the "yes" or "no" boxes.

REFERENDUM BALLOT QUESTION 1

1. Are you in favor of reducing the current number of LRC Representatives from two (2) to one (1) and amending the Constitution as follows?

ARTICLE II, SECTION 1. OFFICERS, COMMITTEES, AND ELECTED EMPLOYEES.

Labor Relations Committee: President and ~~two (2)~~ *one (1)* member elected from the membership at large.

ARTICLE III, SECTION 8 (A & H). LABOR RELATIONS COMMITTEE.

- A. The Labor Relations Committee shall be composed of ~~five (5)~~ *four (4)* members: The President shall be the chairman; Secretary-Business Agent; the Business Agent (Patrolman); and ~~two (2)~~ *one (1)* members shall be elected from the membership at large from the rank and file of the membership, ~~one (1) shall be elected at the December election, and the other at the June election.~~ The terms of office for each shall be for one (1) year.
- H. The Secretary-Business Agent and ~~two (2)~~ *one (1)* members elected at large wages and expenses, if any, shall be in accordance with Article V, Section 1.

ARTICLE IV, SECTION 1 (B). NOMINATIONS

- B. Nomination for Secretary-Business Agent, Business Agent (Patrolman), ~~one (1) Labor Relations Committeeman~~ and three (3) Dispatchers shall be opened on the 15th day of April and shall be closed on the 15th day of May of each year.

ARTICLE IV, SECTION 2 (B). VOTING PROCEDURES

- B. Election for Secretary-Business Agent, Business Agent (Patrolman), ~~one (1) Labor Relations Committeeman~~ and three (3) Dispatchers shall also be by referendum mail ballot. Official ballots shall be mailed no later than May 25. Postmark deadline for return of ballot shall be no later than midnight, June 9. Results shall be posted by 5 p.m. June 12.
