The 2010 Port of Long Beach Scholarship

The Port of Long Beach scholarship is an annual award for Long Beach high school seniors who plan to pursue careers in international trade, goods movement or other port-related industries. It is the Port's goal to provide financial assistance to deserving students and to support them in their quest to become successful professionals and future leaders in the goods movement industry/international trade.

Scholarship awards range from \$1,000 to \$8,000. The award will be disbursed over four years. Each year, scholarship recipients must provide evidence that they remain in good academic standing in a major field related to the port industry.

Eligibility

To qualify as an applicant for the Port of Long Beach Scholarship, candidates must:

- Graduate from the Long Beach Unified School District
- Have a minimum grade point average of 3.0
- Enroll full-time at an accredited college, university, community or junior college or vocational/technical program in the fall of 2010
- Demonstrate financial need
- Plan to major in a field related to international trade, goods movement or other port-related industries. These industries include, but may not be limited to, international business, maritime law, global logistics, engineering, environmental science, and security

Criteria

Scholarship awards are based upon academic ability, potential, professional interest, financial need, character, dedication to the Long Beach community and commitment to international trade and/or the port industry.

Your completed application must be postmarked by Friday, March 19, 2010.

- Official sealed copy of high school transcripts with official Grade Point Average
- Other documentation that you feel is appropriate
- Complete mailing address of the college/university financial aid office. The Port of Long Beach Scholarship is administered by the Long Beach Education Foundation, which will remit the scholarship award check directly to your school of choice. Please include any other pertinent information or instructions required by the college financial aid office, such as a student number.
- Name and phone number of two references
