The Business Office will be closed on Monday, May 26th in observance of the Memorial Day holiday.

<u>WELFARE OPEN ENROLLMENT</u> – Any active or retired member who wishes to change his/her medical and/or dental plan may do so during the month of May by completing the appropriate form(s) in the Business Office; the change will then take effect on July 1<sup>st</sup>. This enrollment month is in addition to one (1) other month of the member's choosing during the year.

<u>PAID HOLIDAY, MONDAY, MAY 26, 2014 – MEMORIAL DAY</u> – Is a normal work day and an automatic holiday for those members who worked at least 1300 hours (1200 hours if age 60 or over) in 2013. For those members who did not meet the automatic holiday requirements, they must be available for work at least two (2) of the four (4) days exclusive of the holiday (Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday, May 27<sup>th</sup>, 28, 29<sup>th</sup> or 30<sup>th</sup>). If a member worked less than 1300 hours but at least 800 hours (700 if age 60 or over) and is on disability during the holiday week, he/she must request the Business Office to file a claim on their behalf or if on vacation during the holiday week, notify the Records Clerk. Reminder – only those members who worked at least 800 hours (700 if age 60 or over) in 2013 are entitled to receive or file for paid holidays.

<u>SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA AREA WELFARE DIRECTOR</u> – Sam Alvarado will continue to be present on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday from 10:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for any Local 63 members who are in need of his services. <u>SUPERCARGO & 30% ISSUES MEETINGS</u> – Effective April  $3^{rd}$  and until further notice these monthly meetings will be held from 5:00-6:00 p.m. in the Harry Bridges Institute (Ste. 209) prior to the Regular Membership Meetings.

<u>ATTENTION TOWER CLERKS</u> — Tower clerks always input chassis information, the only time you can input a flatbed or "own" chassis is if it is a truck flatbed or tri-axle; if you are instructed otherwise, please contact the Business Agent.

<u>TWIC CARDS</u> – The TWIC office has now re-opened. Please check the date on your card; do not allow your card to expire and lose valuable work days unnecessarily.

ONGOING DESMOND BRIDGE CLOSURES – As preparation for the Gerald Desmond Bridge Replacement Project, the contractor plans to close the southbound I-710 freeway to westbound Ocean Blvd. connector ramp at 10 a.m. on Saturday, May 10<sup>th</sup>. The connector will be demolished to clear a path for the new bridge foundations. The closure will remain in effect for approximately 30-months until the new bridge and approach structures are constructed. A temporary closure for the underlying rail tracks and southbound Harbor Scenic Drive will occur from May 23 – 26 (Memorial Day) in order to demolish the structure that spans Harbor Scenic Drive and the rail tracks. COMEBACK FOR ALL NON-SHIP KEY JOBS ARE FOR SEVEN (7) DAYS, (DAYS ONLY). COMPUTER/TOWER JOBS EXEMPTED.

#### GW-27A COMEBACK (NON-SHIP BASIC JOBS) 14 DAYS

COMEBACK FOR ALL NON-SHIP BASIC JOBS ARE FOR 14 DAYS IN SAME CATEGORY AT ONE DOCK.

#### **GW-28 COMEBACK S/C VOLUNTEER**

ANY CLASS "A" VOLUNTEER (NON-QUALIFIED) TAKING A SUPERCARGO JOB MAY BE ALLOWED, BUT NOT REQUIRED, TO WORK THAT JOB UNTIL IT FINISHES (LEGAL CALLBACK).

## GW-30 COMEBACK REPLACEMENT OPBLIGATION

A MEMBER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR HIS OWN REPLACEMENT; THE EMPLOYER CANNOT CALL HIS REPLACEMENT.

# GW-33 MANDATORY COMEBACK REPLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS

ANY CLERK ON A MANDATORY COMEBACK, WHO DOESN'T WISH TO COMEBACK ON A KEY SHIP JOB SUCH AS SUPERCARGO, FLOOR RUNNER, CAR RUNNER, MUST CALL HIS OWN REPLACEMENT THROUGH THE HALL AND TAKE THE FOLLOWING DAY-OFF.

#### GW-34 VESSEL COMEBACK OBLIGATION

ANY CLERK WORKING AGAINST THE SHIP AS A SUPERCARGO, FLOOR RUNNER, CAR RUNNER, OR ANY CLERK IN A SUPERVISORY CAPACITY, MUST ACCEPT A COMEBACK WHENEVER GANGS ARE ORDERED BACK. CHIEF SUPERVISOR EXEMPTED.
