Any member who was off work due to an excused disability on file in the Business Office paid only their Coast Pro Rata and Per Capita which were \$83.87 per month & should multiply the amount(s) times the number of months they paid these figures to Local 63 for their individual total. Any member who was not part of Local 63 for the entire year should multiply the above amount(s) times the number of months they were in the Local to have their actual amount paid.

MESSAGE FROM KENNY URSICH / SAFETY REPRESENTATIVE – Brothers & Sisters: On March 30, 2016, we lost a Local 63 family member Anthony Harris while he was doing his job at Evergreen. Anthony was chalking up a chassis for delivery in the Trans Row. The trucker took off to move to his pile for delivery while Brother Harris was still chalking him up. Anthony was run over by the chassis. After his loss, Local 63 now has a policy in place. When you receive the Truckers Gate Pass, he is to shut down. When you have completed your job and marked him for delivery, then you return his Gate Pass at that point and he can start up again. If he tells you he has mechanical problems, make sure he sets the brakes. Mark him up with caution. Record his gate pass number and license plate. Turn that into the company you are working for. They will ban him from the Terminal until repairs are made. Local 63 members: please do not be ignorant of this policy on the job. Show a good example and help educate Local 13 Members and Casuals that are performing our jobs, so we can all go home at the end of our shift.

PMA IMPLEMENTATION OF SECTION 8.34 FOR CLERKS' NON-AVAILABILITY — PMA is actively pursuing members who do not meet the necessary criteria for this section of the PCCCD regarding availability. Members who do not provide PMA with written medical documentation or request an official Leave of Absence approved through the JPLRC for their time away from the industry may risk possible deregistration. <u>PAID HOLIDAYS</u> – SUNDAY, DECEMBER 24th - CHRISTMAS EVE MONDAY, DECEMBER 25th - CHRISTMAS DAY (DEAD DAY)

To be eligible for Christmas Eve and Christmas Day holiday pay members must be available for work at least two (2) of the four (4) days, Tuesday through Friday, December $26^{th} - 29^{th}$. Members working on Monday, December 25^{th} will be paid at the overtime rate but will NOT count towards the holiday availability date(s) for the holiday pay. Members who are on vacation must notify the Records Clerk no later than December 29^{th} for Christmas Eve and Christmas Day holiday pay.

SUNDAY, DECEMBER 31st – NEW YEAR'S EVE MONDAY, JANUARY 1st – NEW YEAR'S DAY (DEAD DAY)

To be eligible for New Year's Eve and New Year's Day holiday pay members must be available for work at least two (2) of the four (4) days, Tuesday through Friday, January $3^{rd} - 6^{th}$. Members working on Monday, January 2^{nd} will be paid at the overtime rate but will NOT count towards the holiday availability date(s) for New Year's Eve and New Year's Day holiday pay. Members who are on vacation must notify the Records Clerk no later than January 5^{th} for holiday pay.

Members who are on disability for any or all of the two (2) sets of holidays, must submit medical documentation to the Business Office covering the appropriate time and <u>request that a holiday claim be submitted on their behalf.</u>

NOTE: To be eligible to be paid or file a claim for any holidays, members must have worked at least 800 hours (700 if age 60 or over) in 2017.

PAID HOLIDAY – MONDAY, JANUARY 15, 2018 – MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. BIRTHDAY – Is an automatic holiday for those members who worked at least 1300 hours (1200 if age 60 or over) in 2017. Those members who did not, must work at least two (2) of the four (4) days exclusive of the holiday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday, January 16, 17, 18 or 19. Members who are on disability during the holiday week and worked at least 800 hours (700 if age 60 or over) in 2017 but less than 1300 hours (1200 if age 60 or over) in 2017 must submit a doctor's excuse to the Business Office covering them for the holiday week and request that a holiday claim be submitted on their behalf. NOTE: Only those members who worked at least 800 hours in 2017 (700 if age 60 or over) are entitled to receive or file for paid holidays in 2018.
