<u>PAID HOLIDAYS</u> – MONDAY, DECEMBER 24th - CHRISTMAS EVE TUESDAY, DECEMBER 25th - CHRISTMAS DAY (DEAD DAY)

To be eligible for Christmas Eve and Christmas Day holiday pay, members must be available for work at least two (2) of the three (3) days, exclusive of the holidays, Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday, December 26th, 27th or 28th. Members who will be on vacation during that week (Monday-Friday) must notify the Records Clerk no later than December 28th for Christmas Eve and Christmas Day holiday pay.

MONDAY, DECEMBER 31st – NEW YEAR'S EVE TUESDAY, JANUARY 1st – NEW YEAR'S DAY (DEAD DAY)

To be eligible for New Year's Eve and New Year's Day holiday pay members must be available for work at least two (2) of the three (3) days, exclusive of the holidays, Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday, January 2rd, 3rd or 4th. Members who will be on vacation during that week (Monday-Friday) must notify the Records Clerk no later than January 4th for holiday pay.

Members who are on disability for any or all of the two (2) sets of holidays, must submit medical documentation to the Business Office covering the appropriate time and <u>request that a holiday claim be submitted on their behalf.</u>

NOTE: To be eligible to be paid or file a claim for any holidays, members must have worked at least 800 hours (700 if age 60 or over) in 2017.

<u>PAID HOLIDAY – MONDAY, JANUARY 21, 2019 – MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. BIRTHDAY</u> – Is an automatic holiday for those members who worked at least 1300 hours (1200 if age 60 or over) in 2018. Those members who did not, must work at least two (2) of the four (4) days exclusive of the holiday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday, January 22, 23, 24, or 25. Members who are on disability during the holiday week and worked at least 800 hours (700 if age 60 or over) in 2018 but less than 1300 hours (1200 if age 60 or over) in 2018 must submit a doctor's excuse to the Business Office covering them for the holiday week and request that a holiday claim be submitted on their behalf.

NOTE: Only those members who worked at least 800 hours in 2018 (700 if age 60 or over) are entitled to receive or file for paid holidays in 2019.

<u>AGE 60 AND OVER MEETING EXEMPTION RULE REMINDER</u> – As per the Local 63 Constitution, in order to be exempted from being fined for non-attendance of monthly membership meetings, a member must be aged 60 or over, have achieved 5-years in Local 63 and sign the required form in the Business Office; any missed meetings after the signing of the form will not be fined. *Please note, that this only exempts a member from being fined, it does not affect the required availability for check-in rule(s).
