<u>JULY MEMBERSHIP MEETING DATE CHANGE</u> – Please note, due to the first Thursday in July falling on the July 4th Holiday, the Regular Membership Meeting date has been changed to Thursday, July 11th at 6 p.m.

<u>PAID HOLIDAY – THURSDAY, JULY 4TH – INDEPENDENCE DAY</u> – Is an automatic holiday for those members who worked at least 1300 hours (1200 if age 60 or over in 2018). Those members who worked at least 800 hours (700 hours if age 60 or over) but less than 1300 (1200 if age 60 or over) must work two (2) of the three (3) days that week exclusive of the holiday – Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday, July 1st, 2nd, 3rd, to qualify for the paid holiday, or if out on disability during that week, must request that the Business Office file a holiday claim on their behalf with the appropriate medical documentation covering them for that week. *Remember, only members who worked at least 800 hours* (700 if age 60 or over) are entitled to file a holiday claim or receive holiday pay.

NO WORK HOLIDAY – THURSDAY, JULY 5TH - BLOODY THURSDAY – Is a dead day. As was agreed to in past negotiations, Bloody Thursday is a no work holiday but is **NOT** a paid holiday. No work shall be performed between 8:00 a.m. July 5th and 8:00 a.m. July 6th, except for military cargo, passenger vessels, and on-dock rail.

<u>PROMOTIONS COMMITTEE MEETINGS</u> – The next monthly Promotions Committee meeting will be held on Tuesday, July 23th, at 12:00 p.m., in the Labor Room, Ste. 204. Members who are currently Pre-Qualifying & Key-Qualifying are strongly encouraged to attend this meeting to stay updated during their probationary time. It is the member's responsibility to meet with their leader.

<u>APM AUTOMATION</u> - The Port of Los Angeles Harbor Commissioners approved the Coastal Development Permit with a 3-2 vote in favor of APM Terminals. On June 21st, Councilman Buscaino introduced a motion requesting the City Council assert jurisdiction over the Board of Harbor Commissioners' action to deny an appeal and asked the Council to veto the Board of Harbor Commissioners' denial of the appeal and remand the matter back to the Board. On Friday, June 28th, the LA City Council will vote on the Buscaino motion at 10:00 a.m. in the John Ferraro Council Chambers at L.A. City Hall, 200 N. Spring Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012.

RETURNING EQUIPMENT – There have been numerous Employer Complaints recently filed on members for not returning company equipment, i.e. Radios and Truck Keys. For your own protection, make sure to pay attention when returning your checked-out equipment as to who you give it to. If you are returning equipment at a guard shack, make sure there is a guard on duty. If not, contact your Chief or Supercargo to notify them that you are turning in your equipment, but no Guard is on duty. This may save you a trip to the Clerks' LRC. Never give your equipment for someone else to use without first checking it back in where you got it.
