1. Industry Travel

As the situation with with COVID-19 continues to unfold, the Committee met to discuss mutual concerns regarding the voluntary and ordered travel of workers both within and outside of the defined travel areas.

After discussion, the Committee agreed to immediately restrict all workers to their home ports, thereby suspending all voluntary and ordered travel Coastwise, effective 8:00 a.m. Friday, March 13, 2020. In addition, the Committee agreed that all currently authorized visitors on thirty (30) day travel cards are required to immediately return to their home port.

The Committee agreed to immediately advise the JPLRCs of this decision.

The Committee further agreed that the travel restrictions shall remain in place for the next thirty (30) days, and the Committee shall meet to revisit the issue and determine the next appropriate steps following the thirty (30) day period.

The Employers advised the Union that effective immediately training programs Coastwise would be suspended until further notice.
