**DISCUSSION TOPICS**

**ACCIDENT ANALYSIS**

The Committee was provided with the LA/LB injury summary report covering 08/16/2020 to 09/15/2020 [pmap5060]. The report listed 13 LT and 30 NLT injuries for LA/LB.

The monthly injury report was not reviewed and will be covered during the next JAPC.

**OLD BUSINESS**

1. Working at Heights SubCommittee

The subcommittee will hold another drill when appropriate. [Held over].

2. Fuel Barge Refueling

The Secretary noted that all Employers have agreed to notify their steady vessel foremen of the terminals bunker barge procedures.

3. Local 13 Letter to Employers re: Incident Data Collection on Top Handlers vs Pick Up Trucks

4. Crane Bypass Logic Items

5. Disinfectant Hand Wipes

6. Secondary Locking Device on Personnel Cages

The subcommittee reported a request to all marine terminals to send a picture of the secondary means of attachment from the cage to the spreader.

PCMSC Rule1516 was referenced:

*The cage shall be secured to the hoisting apparatus by a positive means. The means of attachment shall have a safety factor of at least five (5) based on the weight of the cage and its maximum rated capacity. Where the cage is secured by twistlocks on the container spreader beam, there shall be a secondary means of attachment.*

**NEW BUSINESS**

1. Information Request re: Bombcart Maintenance

The longshore representative distributed a written information request to the Employers requesting service manuals and related maintenance information related to bombcarts.
