1. Advance Vacation Program and Benefits During the COVID-19 Health Crisis

The Committee agreed to extend the program which allows workers to advance vacation for paid sick time as outlined in CLRC Mtg. No. 29-20 and the associated Q&A Document. The Committee agreed to extend the program through Friday December 24, 2021.

In addition, the Committee discussed vacation eligibility during the COVID-19 health crisis.

The Union requested that PMA provide the Union with information related to 2020 qualifying work hours under Section 7 of the PCL&CA as well as the status of vacation claims filed in 2021. The Union maintained that workers who were on leave in 2020 because (1) they have been advised by a health care provider to self-quarantine due to concerns related to COVID-19; (2) they or a member of their household has been diagnosed with COVID-19; (3) they are providing care to a family member who has been diagnosed with COVID-19; or (4) they are providing care for a child or other household member who cannot attend school or work because it is closed due to COVID-19 receive service credit for the period of such leave to establish eligibility for a qualifying year of past service for additional vacation under Section 7.12.
