# **REVIEW OF JANUARY 06, 2021, JAPC NOTES**

The Committee reviewed the notes from the January meeting.

## **DISCUSSION TOPICS**

## **ACCIDENT ANALYSIS**

The Committee was provided with the LA/LB injury summary report covering 12/16/2021 to 01/20/2022 [pmap5060].

The report listed 38 NLT and 10 lost time ILWU injuries.

The Employers provided additional information on 14 different incident reports requested by the Union.

The Union reminded the Employers the crane or equipment number will be requested during the monthly injury report accident review. In addition, the Union also asked for crane fault and other data following a container crane loss of power / sudden stop.

The Union requested that Employers record if the injury incident involved semi-automatic or newer fully-automatic twistlocks in their investigation report.

In addition, the Longshore representative commented on the need for Employers to conduct and provide a more comprehensive injury investigation, and to track equipment failures to determine equipment fault problems.

## **SERIOUS INCIDENTS**

 A POLA container terminal safety director provided basic details on a recent terminal fatality to a Non-ILWU worker working on a crane raise. The individual was crushed by a crane jib being lifted by a heavy forklift. Current Safety Topics February 3, 2022

### 4. <u>Lashing Gear Handling</u>

Photos provided by a MTO in Charleston were provided to Local 13 of lashing gear being bundled by the container spreader.

The Foreman representative requested a copy of the information. Provided following the meeting.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

## 1. CA Training Funds Grant re: Longshore Training Facility

The Longshore safety representative provided the Committee with details on a recent grant award by CA to be used for a future longshore training facility. Discussions with POLA & POLB continue. The approx. 20 acre facility will take 2-3 years to completion.

## 2. Special JAPC

The Committee briefly discussed the recent Special JAPC focusing on RTG wheel guards and container pile safety. A Tri-Party LRC will be scheduled.
